Ziplorer – designed for BlackBerry® Wireless Handheld

About

Ziplorer is an application that lets you browse through your BlackBerry's® filesystem and unzip .gz and .zip files. Of course with Ziplorer you also can create new zip archives.

Installation

Extract all contents of the .zip file to a single directory and select the .alx in the "Application Loader" of your "BlackBerry Desktop Manager". Follow the instructions and the program will be installed on your BlackBerry®. A more detailed guide on third party program installation can be found here.

What is Zip?

Zip is a standard to compress files and pack multiple files into one file – called zip archive. Zip works with the LZW – Algorithm and can reach very good compression rates.

And what is it good for?

With Ziplorer you are now able to use the great functions of zip on your BlackBerry®: You can pack as many files as you wish into one pkZip (kZip) archive. Having files packed into one single archive is very easy to handle but it is also smaller in size and therefor, it will save time and money when sending it via email.

Furthermore, you are now able to open all zip files you receive e.g. via email attachment, from a normal Windows $^{\circ}$, Unix, Linux or Mac computer.

How to control Ziplorer

Most of Ziplorer functions can be accessed from the main menu. The following lists descriptions and functions of the all menu items of Ziplorer:

"enter dir": Enters the currently focused directory.
"go up": Goes to the directory above the current.
"kZip"*: Packs selected files to a (k)zip archive.
"gZip"*: Packs one selected file to a (g)zip file.
"unzip"*: Unpacks the currently focused .gz or .zip file.
"file info": Gets infos about the currently focused file or folder.


"delete" : Deletes the **selected** files or folders.
"about" : Shows information about Ziplorer.

The button "select all" or "deselect" can either select all files and folders in a in the current directory, or deselect them.

The icons on the left hand side show types of files and folders.
